CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The graduates of the Institute will be able to pursue better future positions in several recognized healthcare setting at national and international levels.

All the applicants must fulfill the following criteria

Two Character Certificates from

- (i) Head of the Last institute attended
- (ii) A responsible officer Medical / Physical Fitness Certificate.

Entry Test shall be conducted for admission in the subjects of English, Science, and General knowledge.

POLICIES FOR SELECTION

1. Application forms will be available at the Institute / Website.
2. Application forms and supporting documents should be submitted before the closing date.
3. No application form will be accepted after due date.
4. Personal interviews and testing dates will be scheduled from time to time. All applicants will be given: written information regarding the dates and timing of the test and interview.
5. All candidates will appear for interview on the fixed date with original documents.
6. The admission committee will select candidates for each discipline, fulfilling the criteria further 3-5 candidates will be selected and placed on the waiting list.



7. Government candidates will be selected on merit basis and nomination from the Government.
8. All selected and waiting list applicants will be notified accordingly.
9. Selected candidates must pay the prescribed fee at the time of admission.

PROMOTION POLICIES

Class achievement and Clinical performance are carefully evaluated. Students will be informed of their progress through periodic conferences by the instructors.

The instructors/course coordinator of each course will outline the grading policies at the beginning of the course.

The minimum passing marks in each subject are 50%

All final exams and final course projects will be completed as indicated by the course teachers.

If the student fails in any subject, he/she will reappear next year in the same semester.

AWARDS

Students will be awarded specific awards that are listed below:

1. Certificates and scholarships will be awarded to students with 80% marks on merit (overall) in each discipline.
2. One outstanding student's award, depending on his/her punctuality, attitude and over all academic performance by academic committee.



ACADEMIC POLICES & PROCEDURES

Attendance in Classes and Clinical Experience:

1. All the candidates must present themselves in the Institute on the first day of the first semester, i.e. orientation day.
2. Class schedules will be posted on the Bulletin Boards.
3. Lab facilities will be available up to 2:00pm.
4. Classroom teaching sessions will be scheduled from 08 am to 02 pm, 05 days per week.
5. All the students are required to attend all classes and clinical sessions. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange and catch up on missed class notes, assignments and / or test.
6. It is necessary to be in the class by 10 minutes before the class starts.
7. Students have to attend 80% of the total clinical experience hours and 85% of the theoretical hours in academic session. If student fails to attend, He /She can be asked to repeat the course in next Semester. (See PNC ruling 1995)

2. LEAVE & HOLIDAYS

1. Regular Assigned Leave:

1. There will be 15 days leave between each semester.
2. During the maternity leave, if the academic session is on, the student will cover up the remaining course work on her own which is left during the leave period.
3. No student shall be allowed to remain absent during clinical experiences.



2. LEAVE OF ABSENCE:

1. Leave of absence for special reasons must be obtained from the Head of the Institution or Coordinator of the class.
2. Students remaining absent from clinical experience will make up his/her loss of experience in coordination with assigned instructor.
3. Students remaining absent from class will have to make acceptable arrangements with the course instructor to cover the missed content in order to fulfill course objectives.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Dress Code:** According to Pakistan Nursing Council:
Boys: White shirt and white pants.
Girls: White shirt with white coat and white Pajama.
2. **Printing and Photostate machine:** The facility of printing and photo copy is available in the campus. Students can utilize this service against set cost by the college.
